The Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration, Army Corps of Engineers, Cape Cod National Seashore, the Woods Hole, Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket Steamship Authority, and the Chair of the Cape Cod Joint Transportation Committee serve as non-voting members of the MPO.
