\*MPO = the **Cape Cod Metropolitan Planning Organization** currently consists of the Executive Office of Transportation, Massachusetts Highway Department, Barnstable County Commissioner, Cape Cod Commission (CCC), Cape Cod Regional Transit Authority, Barnstable, and three Town Selectmen. A Town Selectman Representative is elected from each sub-regional Cape Cod area, entitled "Sub-regions A, B, and C". The sub-region Towns are: Brewster, Chatham, Dennis, Harwich, Yarmouth—; Bourne, Falmouth, Mashpee, Sandwich—, and Eastham, Orleans, Provincetown, Truro, Wellfleet. The MPO Ex-Officio membership includes: Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration, Army Corps of Engineers, National Park Service/Cape Cod National Seashore, Woods Hole, Martha's Vineyard, and Nantucket Steamship Authority, and the Cape Cod Joint Transportation Committee.
