**ADDENDUM**

The *Cape Cod Public Participation Plan 2007 (PPP)*, which provides a process for public involvement in the transportation planning for the region, was endorsed by the MPO at their meeting on June 21, 2007. The Cape Cod Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), through its regular and advisory group meetings, always encourages public participation on changes to major documents.

This **ADDENDUM** to the *Cape Cod Public Participation Plan 2007 (PPP)* proposes the addition of the following provision:

When deemed necessary, as evidenced by an affirmative vote of the MPO, the thirty (30) day time period for accepting public comments on changes to a major document may be reduced to not less than fifteen (15) days.

**Following the release of Draft documents of the RTP, TIP, and other major MPO documents, Transportation Staff will accept comments for approximately 30 days. The public comment period for an update to the PPP is a minimum of 45 days.**

The signatures to follow reaffirm that the current PPP will continue to provide the public participation process for transportation planning in the region, along with the Addendum herein when deemed necessary.
